217.1 SENIOR RECOGNITION REQUIREMENTS

1. Purpose

The Joint Committee will acknowledge each student's successful completion of the instructional program appropriate to the student's interests and needs.

2. Guidelines

A.W. Beattie Career Center

Students who successfully complete their training in any of the courses at A. W. Beattie Career Center shall be awarded a certificate of completion which will indicate the following:

1. Course title and training.
2. Major areas of instruction.
3. Actual number of clock hours or training received.
4. Senior Recognition participation will require the students to maintain a passing grade throughout their senior year, and participate in all senior end-of-year requirements that include: attendance for the school year, senior program exams and completion of related portfolio.

All A. W. Beattie Career Center students will prepare a portfolio throughout their learning experience. The portfolio will include the student's resume, cover letter, list of competencies, awards, references and samples of work, where applicable. Students are free to add to the portfolio as they continue to build their skills. The portfolios shall become the property of the student and may be shown to prospective employers when seeking employment.

Academic Program

Academic Program students must meet the graduation requirements of their home high school in order to receive a high school program diploma from their home school.

Copies of the graduation requirements of each participating district shall be on hand and guide the development of individual long range plans leading toward graduation. The student is then eligible to participate in his/her home school's commencement ceremony, as well as the A. W. Beattie Career Center Senior Recognition program.
